A WORD FROM FATHER BRANDON



Happy and Holy Easter to all !

Today, the Holy Church of God resounds with Hosannas and Glory to God in the Highest! Today, the Holy Church of God shakes with Triumphant cheers of Divine and Cosmic victory over death! Today, the Holy Church of God, our Mother, embraces all Her children with tender sweetness at the realization that She will not lose Her children to the wiles of the enemy, but be crowned eternal in Heaven, as treasures assembled around the Lamb in an eternal festival of praise! This is why The Church gathers today - this is why The Church gathers each Sunday, to remember and to look forward to this day again and again. Without Easter, nothing else we do, nor anything else we experience in this life makes any sense nor points to any meaning or purpose - it just doesn't. Easter brings every joy and every suffering into true focus, and anoints every aspect of our reality with the salve that is the Holy Spirit. So, if only but for a moment today, step into the embrace of your Mother, The Church, and allow yourself to know and feel the Divine and Cosmic joy of this victory won for us!

Though today is the great celebration of victory by the Cross...we still know the Cross. It is the other side of the 'Easter coin', in a sense. The Cross is still there and present in our lives, and the enemy of our human nature will never cease to attempt capture us; to siphon our faith, hope, and love - he just won't. And this bruising reality is often a lot - too much - for some, and it leaves Easter - and every Sunday at that - lacking and, for many, not even worth the attempt at celebrating and reverencing the Mystery of the Resurrection or of our Salvation. So many, and far too many, have simply walked away from, not only The Cross, but the Festival of Joy all together. If you are one of those who just feels the injustice, the hypocrisy, the evil, the sin, the crookedness of the world is just too much to balance with the tremendous Beauty and Mystery of our faith...it's ok. None of us finds it easy. The weight of the Cross for the Lord had Him tumble thrice to the ground; the weight of the cross of the world's brokenness can also lead us to hurl headlong to the ground with despair, cynicism, and apathy towards the Divine. This can lead to a sense of alienation from God or that too much is too far gone, 'I might as well just throw in the towel on this faith thing'! No matter what your cross is - the brokenness of the world or your own brokenness and sin - just heed this advice: rejoice! Rejoice that none of these crosses and none of these hypocrisies and none of these evils that exist and prowl about will have the final victory! Because of Christ and what He has done, not just for humanity, but for you, individually, every pain of every cross is fleeting and never defines us! Let me repeat, you are not defined by or seen by God as the totality and summation of your crosses and tumbles headlong! NO! You are defined as His beloved, who was worth hurling into Hell to slay and defeat all that Hell is and the enemy can do! You and I are Baptized, anointed, fed by the Body of God, and absolved of our sins time and time again! We are infinitely more powerful than any cross - we have God and partake in the Divine life of God! No matter the depth or nature of your relationship with God or your faith...simply keep coming to Him! Rest upon Him, find refuge in Him, let Him be all that you need Him to be - because He will and desires to be your everything! So, don't define yourself by your cross, your doubt, or your sin - define yourself by the nature of The Trinity's Love for you! That, and that alone, is all that matters in life, because that Divine Love is the victory we celebrate today and everyday!
